**PETITIONERS' MANDATORY NOTICES  
UNDER 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(a)(3)**

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(a)(3), Petitioners Apple Inc. and Motorola Mobility LLC (“Petitioners”) hereby update their mandatory notices with respect to related matters to reflect both the transfer of related District Court matters from the Eastern District of Virginia to the Northern District of California and the filing of additional petitions for *inter partes* review.
