What is ONGLYZA?

ONGLYZA is a prescription medicine used along with diet and exercise to lower blood sugar in adults with type 2 diabetes.

 $\mathsf{ONGLYZA}$ should not be used to treat people with type 1diabetes or diabetic ketoacidosis (increased ketones in the blood or urine).

Do not take ONGLYZA if you:

 are allergic to any of its ingredients. Serious allergic reactions can occur with ONGLYZA and may include swelling of the face, lips or throat, difficulty swallowing or breathing, swelling of the skin, hives, rash, itching, flaking, or peeling. If you have these symptoms, stop taking ONGLYZA and contact your doctor right away



PROVEN TO LOWER A1C LEVELS

One of the goals of managing type 2 diabetes is lowering your A1C level to a healthy number. ONGLYZA* (saxagliptin) has been tested in multiple clinical studies and in thousands of adult patients with type 2 diabetes. In all of these studies, once-daily ONGLYZA, in addition to diet and exercise, has been shown to lower A1C levels.

Your healthcare provider will know if ONGLYZA could give you a boost. Ask if adding ONGLYZA is right for you.

24-WEEK CLINICAL STUDY

One 24-week clinical study involved 743 adult type 2 diabetes patients whose blood sugar was not controlled enough by taking metformin IR alone. Of these patients, 564 were given ONGLYZA plus metformin IR and 179 patients were given a placebo plus metformin IR.

The patients started the study with an A1C of 8.1%, on average. After 24 weeks, results showed significant A1C reductions in patients who took ONGLYZA plus metformin IR versus placebo plus metformin IR.

After 24 weeks, more patients who took ONGLYZA plus metformin IR versus placebo plus metformin IR achieved an A1C goal of less than 7%.*

Important Safety Information for ONGLYZA

Serious side effects can happen in people who take ONGLYZA:

Inflammation of the pancreas (pancreatitis) which
may be severe and lead to death. Before taking ONGLYZA,
tell your doctor if you ever had pancreatitis, gallstones,
history of alcoholism, or high triglyceride levels. Stop taking
ONGLYZA and contact your doctor right away if you have
pain in your stomach area (abdomen) that is severe and will
not go away. The pain may be felt going from your abdomen

Not all medicines for type 2 diabetes work the same way. The graphic below demonstrates how ONGLYZA enhances the body's natural ability to control blood sugar, which may help you manage your type 2 diabetes.

ONGLYZA MAY LOWER MORNING BLOOD SUGAR



MORNING BLOOD SUGAR can rise when you're sleeping, due to the pancreas releasing too much glucagon, which makes the liver release too much sugar.

ONGLYZA MAY LOWER AFTER-MEAL SPIKES



AFTER-MEAL BLOOD SUGAR spikes can occur when your pancreas doesn't release enough insulin or your body's cells do not use insulin properly.



ONGLYZA reduces the amount of sugar released by your liver overnight, which may result in lower blood sugar.



ONGLYZA may lower after-meal blood sugar spikes by helping your body increase levels of insulin after meals.

Important Safety Information for ONGLYZA

Serious side effects can happen in people who take ONGLYZA:

- Heart Failure. Before taking ONGLYZA tell your doctor if you have ever had heart failure or problems with your kidneys. Contact your doctor right away if you have any of the following symptoms of heart failure: increasing shortness of breath or trouble breathing, especially when you lie down; an unusually fast increase in weight; swelling
- When ONGLYZA is used with certain other diabetes medicines to treat high blood sugar, such as a sulfonylurea or insulin, the risk of low blood sugar (hypoglycemia) is higher. Symptoms of low blood sugar include shaking, hunger, sweating, headache, rapid heartbeat, change in mood, and change in vision. Follow your doctor's instructions for treating low blood sugar.
