Dear Bill:

Please conduct your standard patentability search for a remote flight recorder and timely aircraft advisory system. The inventor has provided the enclosed preliminary write up and drawings.

What this invention boils down to is replacing the current, on-board flight data recorders (the black boxes they always search for when airplanes crash) with on-board sensors and radio transmitters. Consequently, aircraft flight data can be constantly recorded remotely from the aircraft. This would provide cost and weight savings as well as eliminate the need for a search for the black box when an aircraft crashes. It could also provide an indication of which direction the aircraft went when it failed thus enabling people to better estimate where a downed aircraft can be located.

In addition, with a global communication network in place and a few more sensors, the system will be able to identify components which need to be serviced or replaced and will be able to provide real time emergency advice to cockpit crews.
