In the co-pending litigation Mr. McBride argued the Markman hearings, reviewed prior art references and claim charts for invalidity contentions, and was heavily involved in forming claim construction positions and drafting claim construction briefs, all of which are relied upon in the petition requesting inter parties review of U.S. Patent No. 7,542,045. Patent Owner has expended significant financial resources in the copending litigations with Mr. McBride as counsel, and Patent Owner wishes to continue using Mr. McBride as counsel in this proceeding.

Further, counsel for Petitioners does not oppose Mr. McBride appearing *pro hac vice* this proceeding.
