PLESE TAKE NOTICE that, at the time and place stated above, or as soon
thereafter as the matter may be heard in the courtroom of the Honorable George H.
Wu, United States District Judge, Central District of California, located at
312 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012-4701, Defendants NJOY, Inc.
("NJOY"), CB Distributors, Inc. and DR Distributors, LLC (together, "CB/DR"), ,
FIN Branding Group, LLC and Electronic Cigarettes International Group, Ltd.
(f/k/aVictory Electronic Cigarettes Corporation) (together, "FIN/Victory"),
Ballantyne Brands, LLC ("Ballantyne"), Spark Industries, LLC ("Spark"), Logic
Technology Development LLC ("Logic"), and VMR Products, LLC ("VMR")
(collectively, "Defendants") will and hereby do move this Court for an order of
summary judgment of invalidity of U.S. Patent Nos. 8,899,239; 8,910,641; and
8,689,805.

This Motion is based on the following grounds:

- (a) U.S. Patent No. 8,910,641 is invalid under 35 U.S.C. § 112 for lack of written description support regarding the "liquid source" and "solution storage" limitations. In addition, if the "liquid storage container" term of U.S. Patent No. 8,899,239 is construed to have the same scope as the "liquid source" and "solution storage" terms of U.S. Patent No. 8,910,641, U.S. Patent No. 8,899,239 is also invalid under 35 U.S.C. § 112.
- (b) U.S. Patent Nos. 8,910,641 and 8,899,239 are invalid on separate and independent grounds for anticipation under 35 U.S.C. § 112 in light of the proper priority date.
- (c) U.S. Patent No. 8,689,805 is invalid for obviousness under 35 U.S.C. § 103 based on Wang in view of Liu.

This Motion is made following the conference of counsel pursuant to Local Rule 7-3, which took place on September 8, 2015. Fontem stated that it would oppose this Motion.
