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DETAILED ACTION

Allowable Subject Matter

1. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: Examiner's primary reason for allowance is in the environment of a control apparatus for a vehicle comprising, 'a first control device, located at a vehicle, for generating and transmitting a control signal, first control device is responsive to a second signal, second signal is generated and transmitted by a second control device remote from first control device and second control device is responsive to a third signal, third signal is generated and transmitted by a third control device, third control device is at a location remote from vehicle and second control device, in that signals are sequentially relayed from outside control devices to a control device within the vehicle'.
