As authorized by the Notice of Filing Date Accorded to the Petition (Paper 3¹), Patent Owner M2M Solutions LLC filed a "Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission" (Paper 6, "Mot.") of Michelle Moran.² Petitioners do not oppose the Motion.
