“a building or structure and the grounds or parcel of land adjacent to the building or structure, or a building or structure, or a portion, room, or office, of or in the building or structure, or a mobile home, mobile building, mobile structure, residence, residential building, office, commercial building, commercial structure, equipment, facility, machine, rig, assembly line, or any combination thereof.”

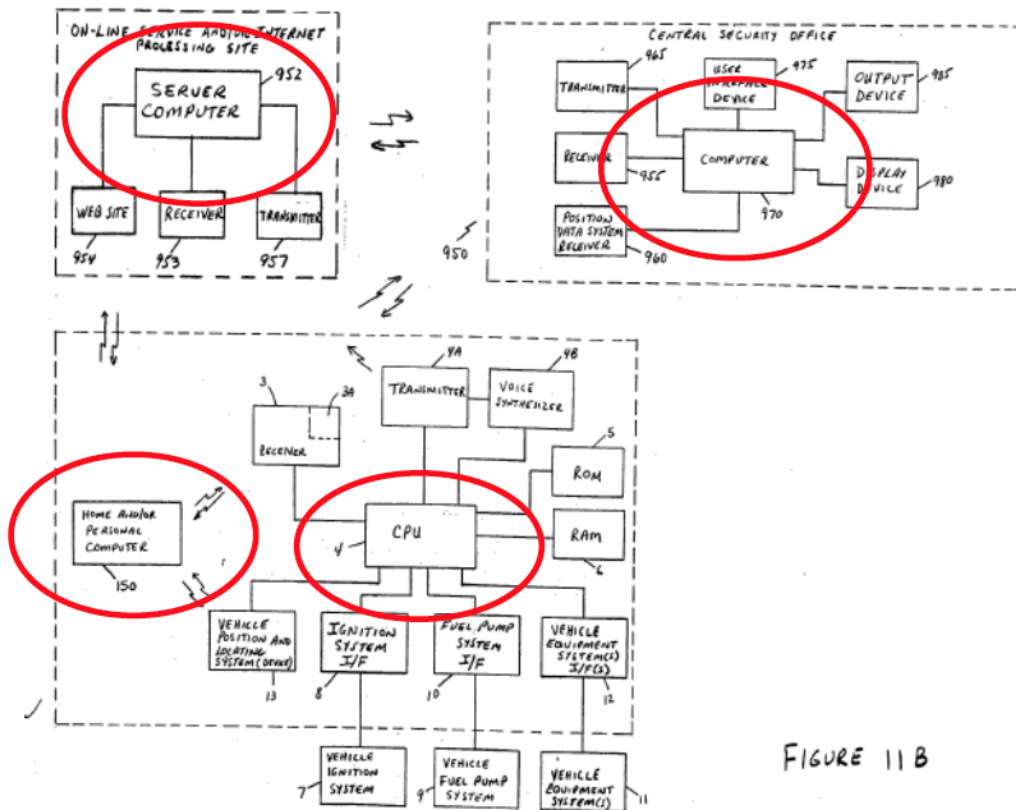
