**DECLARATION OF JEFFREY B. ELIKAN IN SUPPORT OF PATENT

I, Jeffrey B. Elikan, declare as follows:

1. I am a partner in the law firm Covington & Burling LLP.
2. I am a member in good standing of the New York State Bar (admitted 1992) and the District of Columbia Bar (admitted 2000). 

I am familiar with the subject matter and U.S. Patent No. 7,582,621 (“the ’621 Patent”) at issue in this proceeding, including its prosecution history, the related U.S. Patent No. 7,767,657, and the scientific field to which the ’621 Patent is addressed. Over the past several months, I have worked with Anacor Pharmaceuticals, Inc., the Patent Owner in this proceeding, and lead counsel to develop the responses to Petitioner’s invalidity challenges. Specifically, I was involved with retaining experts and working with those experts, whose declarations support the Patent Owner Response. I was also involved in developing the strategy relating to Anacor’s Patent Owner Response. All of the above activities required

developing a thorough understanding of the patent at issue in this proceeding, the prior art, and the relevant scientific field.
