ATHENA: A placebo-controlled, double-blind parallel Trial to assess the efficacy of Dronedarone for the prevention of cardiovascular hospitalization or death from any cause in patients with atrial fibrillation/atrial flutter.

This study established the safety of Dronedarone in patients with atrial fibrillation and the reduction in death, hospitalization and recurrent atrial fibrillation in this high risk patient population.

A Phase 3, Open-label, multi-center, randomized, parallel group study of the efficacy and safety of the fixed combination torcetrapib/atorvastatin administered once daily compared to fixed combination ezetimide./simvastatin for 6 weeks in subjects with Dyslipidemia.

This study established the marked lipid lowering efficacy of torcetrapib (a CETP inhibitor) and atorvastatin in patients with hypercholesterolemia. It also provided information regarding the blood pressure raising properties of torcetrapib which led to the discontinuation of study of this once-promising pharmaceutical product.

JUPITER: A randomized double-blind placebo-controlled multicenter Phase III study of rosuvastatin (Crestor) 20 mg in the primary prevention of cardiovascular events among subjects with low levels of LDL-cholesterol and elevated levels of c-reactive protein.
