3 BRAD A. MYERS, PH.D.,

4 being first duly sworn or affirmed to testify to
5 the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the
6 truth, was examined and testified as follows:

7 EXAMINATION BY COUNSEL FOR THE PATENT OWNER
8 BY MR. HELGE:

9 Q. Good morning, Dr. Myers.

10 A. Good morning.

11 Q. I'm Wayne Helge from Davidson Berquist
12 Jackson & Gowdey. And we are here today for
13 deposition on two U.S. patents that are at issue
14 before the Patent Trial and Appeal Board. And
15 these are cases in which you've provided
