 1003) ("Khazan"), Sirer, and U.S. Patent No. 7,437,362 ("Ben-Natan");
- 4. Secondary considerations of non-obviousness of the '154 Patent;
- 5. Patent Owner's and Petitioner's Motion to Exclude Evidence, if any;

7. Any additional issues on which the Board seeks clarification; and

8. Response to any issues Petitioner raises in its Request for Oral
