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**PATENT OWNER'S REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT**

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.70(a) and the Board's March 21, 2016

Scheduling Order (Paper 9), Patent Owner Finjan, Inc. ("Patent Owner") requests an opportunity to present oral argument regarding the patentability of Claims 1–8, 10, and 11 ("Instituted Claims") of U.S. Patent No. 8,141,154 ("the '154 Patent"). The oral argument is scheduled to be held on December 15, 2016.

Without waiving consideration of any issue not identified below, Patent Owner requests one hour to address the following issues:

1. Whether Petitioner has met its burden that Sirer et al., *Design and Implementation of a Distributed Virtual Machine for Networked Computers* (Exhibit 1004) ("Sirer") is prior art to the '154 Patent;
2. Whether Petitioner has met its burden of proving that Instituted Claims 1–5 of the '154 Patent are unpatentable as obvious over Khazan and Sirer;
3. Whether Petitioner has met its burden of proving that Instituted Claims 6–8, 10, and 11 of the '154 Patent are unpatentable as obvious over Patent Application Pub. No. US 2005/0108562 A1 (Exhibit 1003) ("Khazan"), Sirer, and U.S. Patent No. 7,437,362 ("Ben-Natan");
4. Secondary considerations of non-obviousness of the '154 Patent;
5. Patent Owner's and Petitioner's Motion to Exclude Evidence, if any;

6. Rebuttal of any arguments made by Petitioner;
7. Any additional issues on which the Board seeks clarification; and
8. Response to any issues Petitioner raises in its Request for Oral Argument.

Patent Owner respectfully reserves the right to supplement and/or amend the foregoing statement of issues to the extent the Rules permit.

At oral argument, Patent Owner requests the use of audio/visual equipment to display demonstrative exhibits, including the use of a projector and screen. In addition, Patent Owner's expert, Dr. Nenad Medvidovic, may attend the hearing to answer any questions the Board may have.
