PATENT OWNER'S OBJECTIONS TO EVIDENCE UNDER 37 C.F.R. § 42.64



Patent Owner Finjan, Inc. ("Finjan") objects under the Federal Rules of Evidence and 37 C.F.R. § 42.64 to the admissibility of the declaration of Dr. Aviel Rubin (the "Rubin Declaration") and the annotated figures included in Petitioner's Petition submitted by Palo Alto Networks, Inc. ("Petitioner").

The Institution Decision issued on April 20, 2016. Paper No. 10. The Board instituted trial for claims 1-8, 10, and 11 on the ground of obviousness over Ross under 35 U.S.C. § 103. *Id.* Finjan's objections are timely under 37 C.F.R. § 42.64(b)(1). Finjan serves Petitioner these objections to provide notice that Finjan will move to exclude the evidence as improper evidence.


I. Rubin Declaration (Ex. 1002)

Finjan objects to the admissibility of the Rubin Declaration for at least the following reasons: Under **FRE 702**, Dr. Aviel Rubin's opinions are inadmissible because they are conclusory, do not disclose underlying facts or data in support of his opinions, and are unreliable. Additionally, Dr. Aviel Rubin is unqualified as an expert to provide technical opinions of a person skilled in the art. *See* Ex. 1002, Ex. A (Curriculum Vitae of Dr. Aviel Rubin). As such, his opinions are inadmissible under **FRE 702**. His opinions are also irrelevant, confusing, and of minimal probative value under **FRE 401**, **402**, and **403**.




II. Annotated Figures
