11 EXAMINATION

12 BY MR. COHEN:

13 Q. Good morning, Mr. Seifert.

14 A. Good morning.

15 Q. My name is Justin Cohen. I am representing the
16 plaintiffs in this case, ChriMar Systems, Inc. and
17 ChriMar Holding Company.

18 Are you are familiar with them?

19 A. I am.

20 Q. Now, you've been deposed numerous times before;
21 correct?

22 A. Yes.

23 Q. Do you know about how many?

24 A. Between 10 and 20.

25 Q. So you generally understand the process and the

6 Q. Anything affecting your ability to understand
7 my questions today?

8 A. No.

9 I do want to go on the record -- if you notice,
10 I've got -- we don't have video here, but if you notice,
11 I've got an earpiece on and I've got an iPod sitting in
12 front of me. I suffer from tinnitus, ringing of the
13 ears. And this helps mask it. It makes me tolerate it
14 a little bit better. It's actually a creation of my own
15 design. So I just wanted to make sure you don't think
16 I'm getting messages from somewhere else or from
17 anywhere, so...

18 Q. Thank you.

19 A. And at some point, I may have to change
20 earpieces, because the batteries last a finite time.

21 Q. Can you hear my questions okay?

22 A. I can hear you fine. It's not a hearing aid.
23 It's actually injecting a masking sound, which helps
24 relieve the ringing.

25 Q. Okay. Thank you for that.
