10 you, and please answer verbally because the
11 reporter can't record head shakes or nods or

13 or no or other verbal responses. Will you do
14 that?

15 A. I'll be glad to do that.

16 Q. Similarly, please wait until I
17 finish asking my questions completely before
18 beginning your answer because it's difficult
19 for the reporter to record if we're talking
20 over one another. Will you do that?

21 A. Yes, I will.

22 Q. And please make sure you understand
23 each question. If I ask a question that you
24 don't understand, please don't answer it.
