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DECISION Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission 37 C.F.R. § 42.10

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As authorized by the Notice of Filing Date Accorded to Petition (Paper 3, 2),² Patent Owner TriPlay, Inc. filed a Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Douglas Weider. Paper 10. Patent Owner also filed Exhibit 2001, Affidavit of Douglas Weider, in support of the motion. *Id.* at 3. The Motion is unopposed. Because the Motion and accompanying affidavit comply with the requirements of 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c), as well as the requirements set forth in Case IPR2013-00639, Paper 7,³ the Motion is *granted*.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Patent Owner's motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Mr. Weider is *granted*, and Mr. Weider is authorized to represent Patent Owner as back-up counsel in IPR2016-00717 and IPR2016-00718;

FURTHER ORDERED that Patent Owner is to continue to have a registered practitioner as lead counsel in this *inter partes* review proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Weider is to comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Title 37, Part 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Weider is subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et seq*.
