Examiner contacted Applicant's representative Mr. Freistein ("Applicant") to discuss allowable subject matter in the application. Examiner noted that the claims are drawn to the same invention as in parent application 10/500,354, thereby requiring a terminal disclaimer in the instant application. Examiner also noted that the instant application is a continuation vs. a divisional of the parent application, and therefore a supplemental Application Data Sheet would be required noting said change, as well as amending the specification. Examiner further noted an objection to claim 24, wherein the last line of the claim should read, "the aqueous liquid preparation has a pH in the range of 5-8". Applicant agreed to said changes and noted the amendments, terminal disclaimer, and supplemental ADS would be filed in due course.
