On January 3, 2017, the Patent Trial and Appeal Board (the "Board") instituted an *inter partes* review (the "IPR") trial, pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 314(a), as to Claims 1, 2, 8, 11, 15-19, 94, 95, 102, 109-113, 128, 163, 164, 166-168, 175, and 179-181 of Patent No. 8,457,113 (the "Challenged Claims" and the "113 Patent," respectively) that the Challenged Claims were obvious over 1) Archer and the knowledge of a POSA and 2) Archer and Chang. *See* Decision Granting Institution of *Inter Partes* Review, Jan. 3, 2017, Paper No. 19 (the "Institution Decision").
