PETITIONER'S UPDATED MANDATORY NOTICES PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. § 42.8



Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(a)(3), R.J. Reynolds Vapor Company ("Reynolds" or "Petitioner") submits the following updated mandatory notices, which supersede the notice of real party-in-interest and the notice of related matters that Petitioner filed previously.

I. NOTICE OF REAL PARTY-IN-INTEREST (37 C.F.R. § 42.8(B)(1))

For purposes of 35 U.S.C. § 312(a)(2) and 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(b)(1) only, Petitioner, R.J. Reynolds Vapor Company, identifies the real parties-in-interest as R.J. Reynolds Vapor Company, RAI Strategic Holdings, Inc., RAI Innovations Company (the direct parent company of R.J. Reynolds Vapor Company and RAI Strategic Holdings, Inc.), R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company, and RAI Services Company. Each of the foregoing entities is a direct or indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Reynolds American Inc. Although Petitioner does not believe that Reynolds American Inc. is a real party-in-interest (*see* Patent Trial Practice Guide 77 Fed. Reg., Vol. 77, No. 157 (2012) at 48759-60), Reynolds American Inc. and each of its other wholly owned subsidiaries (direct and indirect) nevertheless agree to be bound by any final written decision in these proceedings to the same extent as a real party-in-interest. *See* 35 U.S.C. § 315(e).
