ORDER  
Petitioner's's Motion for *Pro Hac Vice*  
Admission of Kerry B. McTigue  
*37 C.F.R. § 42.10*

Petitioner has filed a motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Kerry B. McTigue in the above-captioned proceeding. Paper 28. The motion is supported by a declaration of Mr. McTigue. Ex. 1029. Patent Owner did not file an opposition to the motion.

We determine that the requirements of 37 C.F.R. § 42.10 have been met and there is good cause to admit Mr. McTigue *pro hac vice*.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED that Petitioner's Motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Kerry B. McTigue is *granted*; Mr. McTigue is authorized to act as back-up counsel in the instant proceeding only;

FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner is to continue to have a registered practitioner represent it as lead counsel for the instant proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. McTigue is to comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Part 42 of Title 37, Code of Federal Regulations; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. McTigue is to be subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et seq.*
