#### **ORDER**

Granting Petitioner's Motion for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* of Kayvan B. Noroozi 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)

Reg. 48,755 (Aug. 14, 2012), and are subject to disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a).

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Petitioner's motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Mr. Noroozi is *granted*; Mr. Noroozi may represent Petitioner only as backup counsel in the instant proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner is to continue to have a registered practitioner represent it as lead counsel in the instant proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Noroozi shall comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Part 42 of the C.F.R.; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Noroozi shall be subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a) and the Office's Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101–11.901.
