1 S C O T T A N D R E W S, having
2 been first duly sworn by a
3 Notary Public of the State of

6 EXAMINATION BY

7 MR. FAHMI:

8 Q. What is your current address?

9 A. 704 Paula Lane, Petaluma,
10 California 94052.

11 Q. Would you state your name for
12 the record, please.

13 A. Scott Andrews.

14 Q. Good morning, Mr. Andrews.
15 My name is Tarek Fahmi and I'm here
16 representing Signal IP. This is my
17 colleague Jason LaBerteaux.

18 MR. CHAPMAN: Let me introduce
19 Mr. Andrews as the witness. I'm
20 Mark Chapman at Kenyon and Kenyon
21 for the witness and Toyota. And
22 with me are two colleagues, Dragan
23 Plavsic and Kulsoom Hasan.

24 Q. Mr. Andrews, have you ever
25 given a deposition before?

1 A. Yes, I have.

2 Q. Approximately how many times?

3 A. Maybe twenty.

4 Q. I'm sure you've heard some of
5 these instructions before but just so
6 that we have a common understanding,
7 during today's deposition I'll be
8 asking questions and you'll be
9 providing answers. But if I ask a
10 question that is unclear or you didn't
11 understand or you just want me to
12 repeat it for any reason, just let me
13 know. I'll be happy to repeat it or
14 rephrase it if it wasn't clear, try to
15 make it more clear. I just need to
16 know that you want it repeated or
17 rephrased.

18 Okay?

19 A. Okay.

20 Q. On the other hand, if you
21 answer a question and you haven't asked
22 me to rephrase it or repeat it, I'm
23 going to assume that you're answering
24 the question that I've asked.

25 All right?

1 A. Yes.

2 Q. As you're doing, if you'd
3 please continue to give audible
4 answers, that will help the court
5 reporter with his job. He can't really
6 take down gestures or nods of the head
7 or mumbles or that sort of thing, so
8 audible answers, please.

9 A. All right.

10 Q. Also, as you're doing, if you
11 would please wait until I finished
12 asking the question before you give
13 your answer, I'll try and do the same
14 and make sure that you wait until
15 you've finished your answer before I
16 ask another question. Again, this
17 helps the court reporter keep a clear
18 record. He only has to worry about
19 taking down what one person is saying
20 at a time.

21 Is that all right?

22 A. Yes.

23 Q. Is there any reason you can't
24 give your best testimony here today?

25 A. No.
