14 Hoffman, and Christine Yang on behalf of
15 petitioner D-Link Systems Inc.

16 JUDGE WEINSCHENK: Okay. Ms. Hao,

9 MS. HAO: Thank you, Your Honor.
10 This is Victoria Hao again on behalf of
11 petitioner D-Link Systems.

12 Your Honor, without moving for
13 additional discovery, the patent owner
14 elected to file its preliminary
15 responses, in part, alleging
16 insufficient disclosure of the real
17 party-in-interest. And this is a new
18 issue, argument raised by the patent
19 owner, although there is burden on the
20 petitioner to prove a named third party
21 or the real party-in-interest for the
22 petition, we would like to have this
23 opportunity to discuss it with the
24 board, to see whether a short reply
25 could be more completed, both on factual
