8 EXAMINATION

9 BY MR. BANSAL:

10 Q. Good morning, Dr. Flamm.

11 A. Good morning.

12 Q. Can you please state and spell your full
13 name for the record?

14 A. My full name is Daniel Lawrence Flamm.

15 MR. STADHEIM: Before we proceed, I -- I
16 want to make a correction in the declaration. If
17 you look at paragraph --
