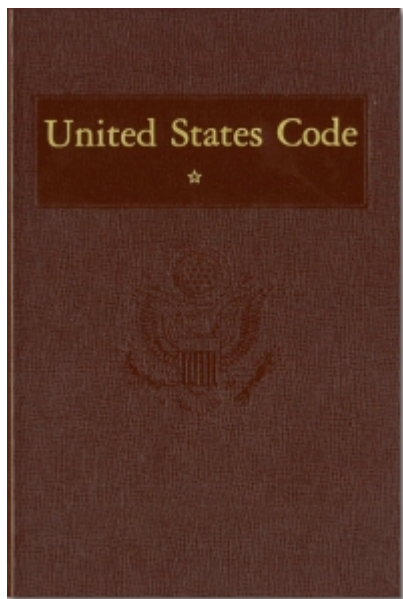

Scope Of IPR Review – Set by Director's determination

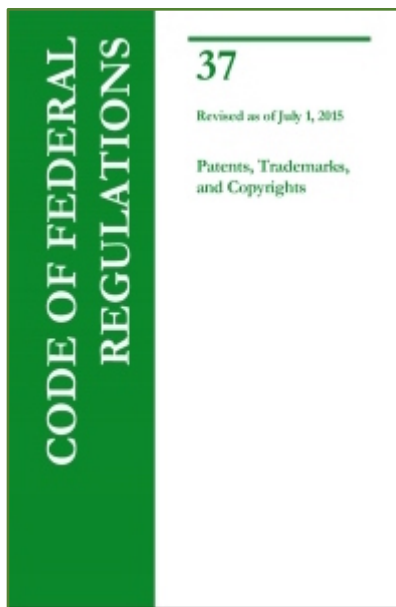


(a) The Director may not authorize an IPR to be instituted unless the Director determines that the evidence presented in the petition filed under section 313 ***shows that there is a reasonable likelihood that the petitioner would prevail*** with respect to the claims challenged in the petition

(c) The Director shall notify the petitioner, in writing, of the ***Director's determination***.

(d) The determination by the Director on a petition for IPR review under this section ***shall***

Scope Of IPR Review – Set Under Office Rules



(a) ***Institution of trial.*** The Board instituted the trial on the date the Director.

37 C.F.R. § 42.4

(a) When instituting inter partes review, the Board may deny some or all grounds for unpatentability. ***review to proceed on all or some of the grounds for unpatentability or some of the grounds of unpatentability.***

(b) At any time prior to institution of inter partes review, the Board may deny some or all grounds for unpatentability. ***Denial of a ground for unpatentability does not preclude the Board from instituting inter partes review on that ground.***
