Whether claims 1–17 of the '396 patent are unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 103 as obvious over U.S. Patent No. 6,563,892 (including documents incorporated by reference therein) and a paper by G.B. Giannakis et al., *Load-Adaptive MUI/ISI-Resilient Generalized Multi-Carrier CDMA with Linear and DF Receivers*, Vol. 11, No. 6, EUROPEAN TRANSACTIONS ON TELECOMMUNICATIONS 527–37 (2000);



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 Any additional issues on which the Board seeks clarification. The Board has already scheduled Oral Hearing for November 6, 2017. See Scheduling Order of February 22, 2017, Paper No. 9.

Petitioner also requests that the Board provide audio-visual equipment to display a demonstrative PowerPoint presentation. The requested equipment includes a projector to be connected to Petitioner's laptop computer, and a screen for displaying the projected image.
