## **ORDER**

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Reyes shall provide the Board with the name of his law firm and an email address at which he may be contacted; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Reyes shall be subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a) and the Office's Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101–11.901.
