However, the EPO is no longer a competent IPEA, within the meaning of PCT Article 32(3), for international applications filed by US residents or nationals in the USPTO or IB as Receiving Office where the corresponding demand is filed with the EPO on or after 01 March 2002, and where the application contains one or more claims directed to the fields of biotechnology, business methods or telecommunication. For the definition of what the EPO considers to be precluded subject matter in the field of telecommunication, applicants should see the "Notice from the President of the European Patent Office," dated 26 November 2001, and which is published as Annex A in the "Notice Concerning EPO Competence to Act as PCT Authority" in the Official Gazette at 1255 O.G. 878, on February 19, 2002.
