


Use the Fine Adjustment Wheel to Control Fine Positioning of the THV

Ensure the Flex Tip is pulled back to the middle of the Triple Marker

⋳ Ensure the Balloon Lock is locked

Turn the Fine Adjustment Wheel to finely control the THV position in either direction





NOTE:

Be patient during initial fine adjustment. The Flex Catheter may need to be supported by the aortic arch to help enable fine positioning
