**ORDER**

The parties to this case are involved in parallel proceedings in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan, Civil Action No. 15-cv-10628. On October 22, 2015, the parties notified this court that an October 14, 2015 Opinion and Order was entered in that case by the Hon. Matthew F. Leitman. Judge Leitman denied Versata's Motion to Dismiss, or Alternatively to Transfer to the Eastern District of Texas.

As the first-filed court has retained jurisdiction, it is ORDERED that on or before November 30, 2015 the parties shall file notice of any good faith reasons that this case should not be dismissed, without prejudice, so that the issues may dealt with in the Michigan court. Absent the filing of notice by either side the case will be so dismissed.
