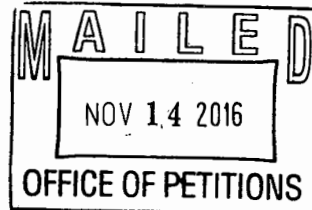

This is a decision on the petition filed on May 26, 2016, which is treated as a petition under 37 CFR 1.78(e) to accept an unintentionally delayed claim under 35 U.S.C. § 120 for the benefit of priority to the prior-filed nonprovisional application, by way of a certificate of correction. This is also a decision on the under 37 CFR 1.182 for expedited consideration of the above-referenced petition under 37 CFR 1.78(e).

The petition under 37 CFR 1.182 is **GRANTED** to the extent that the petition under 37 CFR 1.78(e) is hereby given expedited consideration.

The petition under 37 CFR 1.78(e) is **DISMISSED**.

A petition for acceptance of a claim for late priority under 37 CFR § 1.78(e) is only applicable to those applications filed after the expiration of the period specified in 37 CFR § 1.78(d)(3). In addition, the petition under 37 CFR § 1.78(e) must be accompanied by:

- (1) the reference required by 35 U.S.C. § 120 and 37 CFR § 1.78(d)(2) of the prior-filed application, which must be filed in an Application Data Sheet, unless previously submitted;
- (2) the petition fee set forth in § 1.17(m); and
- (3) a statement that the entire delay between the date the claim was due under 37 CFR § 1.78(d)(3) and the date the claim was filed
