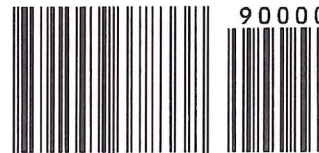

document assembly In word processing, the merging of documents from previous sessions. The text in the new document plate text in accordance with the names and addresses in the old document embedded in the text of the new document merge.

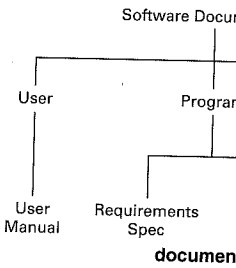
documentation (1) (nuclear) Written or pictorial information that describes, verifies, reports or certifies procedures, or results.

(2) (A) (software) A collection of documents that describe a project. **(B) (software)** Any written or pictorial information describing, defining, specifying, or certifying procedures, requirements, procedures, or results. The management of documentation includes the process of generating or reviewing documents, their acquisition, processing, storage,

documentation assertion An assertion that the documentation associated with a project meets the requirements of (C/PA) 1326.

documentation level See: level of documentation

documentation tree A diagram that shows the relationship between documents for a given system and shows the flow of information between other. See also: specification



Document Composition Facility A software language, developed by IBM, for generating formatted documents.

document cycle The steps involved in the production of a document. Note: The cycle includes production, reproduction, distribution, and archiving. Also: information traffic.

document editor A text editor that allows users to edit documents. Synonym: manuscript editor.

document mark In micrograph reproduction, a mark for counting images or film frames. Also: blip.

document merge See: document assembly

document page count The total number of pages contained in a hard-copy document.

document reader A device that interprets information contained on microfilm, microfiche, cards or paper. For example,
