Claims 1-26. (Canceled)

Claim 27. (Currently Amended) A stent crimper comprising:

a plurality of movable dies arranged to form an iris having a longitudinal axis, the iris defining an aperture of a substantially regular polygonal shape, the dies disposed about the aperture and between stationary end-walls which are disposed about the longitudinal axis, at least one of the stationary end-walls operatively engaged to the dies at distinct connection locations such that the number of distinct connection locations and the number of dies are the same;

each die having a first straight side and a second straight side, the first straight side and the second straight side converging to form a tip; wherein a portion of the first straight side of each die faces the aperture, each first straight side parallel to the second side of an adjacent die Claim 28. (Previously presented) The stent crimper of claim 27 having a rotatable actuation device coupled to the dies, rotation of the actuation device causing the dies to move inward and reduce the size of the aperture or outward so as to increase the size of the aperture.
