6 COURTROOM ADMINISTRATOR: All rise.

7 THE COURT: Thank you. You may be seated.

8 COURTROOM ADMINISTRATOR: This is the time set
9 for the jury trial in case number 2:11-cv-1578-GMN-PAL,
10 Silver State Intellectual Technologies, Inc., versus Garmin
11 International, Inc.

12 Counsel, please state your appearances for the
13 record.

14 MR. BERRETTA: Good afternoon, Your Honor. Fred
15 Berretta of Knobbe Martens for the Plaintiff Silver State.

16 With me are my colleagues Marko Zoretic, Yanna
17 Bouris, Loni Morrow, and Craig Summers, and Mr. Michael
18 Obradovich of Silver State.

19 THE COURT: Good afternoon.

20 MR. BERRETTA: Good afternoon.

21 MR. GROOMBRIDGE: Good afternoon, Your Honor.
22 Nicholas Groombridge for the defendants, joined by
23 Ms. Jenny Wu, Mr. Matthew Zorn, and Mr. Philip May.

24 THE COURT: And good afternoon as well.

25 MR. GROOMBRIDGE: And of course, Mr. Jay Dee

1 Krull from Garmin.

2 THE COURT: Yes.

3 All right. So is there a matter that you wanted
4 to take up before we bring in the jury?

5 MR. BERRETTA: There were actually three
6 matters, Your Honor.

7 The first is that we are going to rest our case
8 this morning. We're not going to bring back Dr. -- we
9 hadn't planned on bringing back Dr. Sullivan for redirect.

10 We -- he had a flight to go home, and we
11 realized after we left the courtroom that the jury might
12 have actually had questions for him. I apologize for that.

13 We can -- he's available by phone, or he will be
14 coming back in rebuttal. He could deal with any questions
15 at that time. So we just wanted to let the Court know in
16 case the jury had questions for Dr. Sullivan, and we
17 weren't sure if they did or not.

18 THE COURT: All right. Well, this jury has not
19 been asking many questions, so I don't think it will be a
20 big problem. We'll see if they have any questions first,
21 and, if they do, then we can go from there.

22 Is there any record that you'd like to make,
23 Mr. Groombridge, as to that particular issue? Did you
24 think he was going to be -- you were done with your cross,
25 correct?
