Pursuant to the Board's Order on the conduct of the proceedings entered on December 7, 2017, Patent Owner provides this emailed status report on the bankruptcy proceedings in Case No. 17-14849 in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Oklahoma.

In the bankruptcy proceedings, Doug Gould has been appointed as the bankruptcy trustee, and the First Meeting of Creditors is scheduled for January 2, 2018 at 2:00pm CST, which is the first opportunity for the creditors to have involvement in the bankruptcy proceedings and those proceedings' protection of the creditors' interest in Patent Owner's assets, which include the patents that are the subject of the current IPR proceedings.
