#### PRIVACY STATEMENT

D-Lib is an Internet-based magazine with a world-wide audience, committed to providing its readers with digital library-related articles licensed by authors for publication. The Corporation for National Research Initiatives (CNRI), which produces the magazine, does not collect personally identifying information about individuals who visit this web site. Our logs collect and store only domain names; dates and times of visits; the pages visited; and types of browsers used. Data from the logs are used to measure the number of visitors to the site.

Subscribers may join and leave the subscriber list using an automated maillist program. The subscriber list is used solely by the Editor to notify subscribers about site updates and/or the release of new issues. The subscriber list is not provided to any third parties, nor can subscribers post messages to the list.
