7 Q. Good morning, Dr. Vaux.

12 this. There's -- I am not familiar with
13 treating with that. We use sodium benzoate a
14 lot.

15 Q. And sodium benzoate is equivalent
16 to?

17 A. It's another one of the nitrogen
18 scavenging drugs.

19 Q. So, based upon your review of the
20 prior art and your interaction with other
21 doctors that have UCD patients that they are
22 treating, are you aware of any difference in
23 the efficacy between Buphenyl and Ravicti when
24 administered to a UCD patient?
