Regarding service of demonstratives (37 CFR 42.70(b)), the Petitioners in the above-captioned proceedings seek a modification of the time for service from July 5 to July 11 at 10 pm ET. Patent Owner has indicated that it does not oppose Petitioners' request so long as it is mutual.
