On June 23, 2021, this court ordered the parties to respond how they believe the above-captioned appeals should proceed in light of *United States v. Arthrex, Inc.*, 141 S. Ct. 1970 (2021). In response, Uniloc 2017 LLC states that it no longer wishes to pursue its Appointments Clause challenge.
