DECISION

Dismissing as Moot Petitioner's Request for Rehearing  
*37 C.F.R. § 42.71(d)*

## I. INTRODUCTION

Petitioner requested rehearing of the Board's February 6, 2018, Decision on Institution (Paper 9), insofar as the institution decision declined to institute *inter partes* review of claim 3 of the '747 patent. Paper 11.

On May 2, 2018, in view of the Supreme Court's decision in *SAS Institute Inc. v. Iancu*, 2018 WL 1914661, at \*10 (U.S. Apr. 24, 2018), we entered an Order modifying our institution decision to institute on all of the challenged claims on the ground presented in the Petition. Paper 16. In light of that order, we now dismiss Petitioner's Request for Rehearing as moot.

Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Petitioner's Request for Rehearing (Paper 11) is *dismissed as moot*.
