ORDER

Granting Patent Owner Horizon Pharma USA, Inc.'s
Motion for Ellen Scordino to Appear *Pro Hac Vice*
37 C.F.R. § 42.10

Patent Owner Horizon Pharma USA, Inc. ("Horizon") filed a Motion for Ellen Scordino to Appear *Pro Hac Vice* under 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c). Paper 32. The Motion is supported by the Declaration of Ms. Scordino. Paper 33. Horizon represents that Petitioner does not oppose this motion. Paper 32, 2.

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The Board has reviewed the submissions and determined that the requirements of 37 C.F.R. § 42.10 have been met and there is good cause to admit Ms. Scordino *pro hac vice* in the proceeding.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED that Horizon's Motion for Ellen Scordino to Appear *Pro Hac Vice* under 37 C.F.R. § 42.10 is *granted*;

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Scordino is authorized to represent Horizon as back-up counsel only, and that Horizon is to continue to have a registered practitioner represent it as lead counsel;

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Scordino shall comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Part 42 of 37 C.F.R.; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Scordino shall be subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a) and the Office's Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101–11.901.
