OpenTV objects to Exhibit 1006 under Rules 403 and 702 of the Federal Rules of Evidence and 37 C.F.R. § 42.65. Mr. Bradner's opinions are conclusory, lack sufficient explanation, are not based on sufficient facts or data, and are not the product of reliable principles and methods reliably applied to the facts of the case, at least because Mr. Bradner opines on claim construction but fails to apply or consider relevant law on claim construction, *see*, *e.g.*, Ex. 1006 at ¶¶ 14-17, 93-104, and because Mr. Bradner lacks the relevant technical experience necessary to opine on claim construction or patentability. Accordingly, Ex. 1006 is an improper declaration and is more prejudicial than it is of probative value.
