method for managing data comprising the steps of: establishing communications between a handheld mputing device and an originating computer wherein id handheld computing device has a GPS integral ereto;

eceiving within said handheld computing device a nsmission of a tokenized questionnaire from said iginating computer, said tokenized questionnaire cluding at least one question requesting location entifying information, said tokenized questionnaire mprising a plurality of device independent tokens; nding said communications between said handheld mputing device and said originating computer; fter said communications has been ended,

1) executing at least a portion of said plurality of tokens comprising said questionnaire on said handheld computing device to collect at least one response from a first user, and,

2) storing within said computing device said at least one response from the first user;

- (d3) using said GPS to automatically obtain said location identifying information in response to said at least one question that requests location identifying information;
- (e) establishing communications between said handheld computing device and a recipient computer;
- (f) transmitting a value representative of each of said at least one response stored within said handheld computing device to said recipient computer; and,
- (g) after receipt of said transmission of step (f), transmitting a notice of said received value representative of each of said at least one response to a second user.
