ORDER

*Granting Petitioner's Motion for
Pro Hac Vice Admission of Caroline Bader
37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)*

Petitioner filed a motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Ms. Caroline Bader along with a supporting declaration by Ms. Bader. *See, e.g.*, Paper 6 (“Mot.”); Ex. 1013. Patent Owner has not opposed Petitioner’s motion.

Petitioner’s lead counsel, Eric A. Buresh, is a registered practitioner. Mot. 1. Petitioner has shown by its Motion and Ms. Bader’s declaration that Ms. Bader is an experienced litigating attorney and has an established familiarity with the subject matter at issue in the proceeding. *See e.g.*, Mot. 1–2; Ex. 1013 ¶¶ 8–11; *see also* 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c).

Based upon consideration of the motion and the record before us, we grant Petitioner’s Motion for Admission of Ms. Bader.

It is therefore ORDERED that Petitioner’s unopposed motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Ms. Bader to represent Petitioner in the instant proceeding as back-up counsel, is granted;

FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner is to continue to have a registered practitioner as lead counsel in the instant proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Bader is to comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board’s Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Title 37, Part 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations;

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Bader is to be subject to the Office’s disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et. seq.*
