2 JUDGE McNAMARA: Good afternoon,  
3 everyone. This is Judge McNamara. I'm on  
4 the line. Judge Dougal and Judge White are  
5 also on the line.

6 Is anyone on the line for the  
7 Petitioner?

8 MS. HIGGINS: Yes, your Honor.  
9 This is Gabrielle Higgins and Kathryn Hong on  
10 behalf of Petitioner. Petitioner singular.

11 JUDGE McNAMARA: All right. That's  
12 Petitioner Vizio; is that right?

13 MS. HIGGINS: Yes.

14 JUDGE McNAMARA: Okay. And how  
15 about for the Patent Owner?

16 MR. ZOLTICK: Yes. For the Patent  
17 Owner, your Honor, Marty Zoltick and my  
18 colleague, Michael Jones.

19 JUDGE McNAMARA: Okay. And I
