- 1. The proper construction of claim elements in U.S. Patent No. 9,364,435;
- 2. The unpatentability of claims 1-20 of U.S. Patent No. 9,364,435 under §103 in view of the WO2005/007196 ("'196 PCT") and US2006/0134189 ("'189 publication");
- 3. The unpatentability of claims 1-20 of U.S. Patent No. 9,364,435 under §103 in view of each of the '196 PCT and the '189 publication in view of Lin and/or Ahmad;
- 4. The unpatentability of claims 1-20 of U.S. Patent No. 9,364,435 under §102/§103 in view of US2006/0240554 ('544 publication);
- 5. The unpatentability of the substitute claim in Patent Owner's contingent motion to amend in light of the foregoing, and issues raised in the briefing relating thereto;



- 6. Respond to any issues specified by Patent Owner in its request for oral argument or otherwise presented by the Patent Owner; and,
- 7. Any additional issues on which the Board seeks clarification.

Petitioner understands that oral argument in IPR2018-00739 (Scheduling Order, Paper 16) and IPR2018-00680 (Scheduling Order, Paper 14) will be held on June 6, 2019.
