Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2(a), 90.3 and 35 U.S.C. §§ 141(c), 142, and 319, Protiva Biotherapeutics, Inc. ("Patent Owner") respectfully gives notice that in reference to Moderna Therapeutics, Inc.'s Notice of Appeal dated November 13, 2019, it cross-appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Patent Trial and Appeal Board's Final Written Decision entered on September 11, 2019 (Paper 51), and from all other underlying orders, decisions, rulings, and opinions.

For the limited purpose of providing the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office with the information specified in 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), the issues on cross-appeal include the Board's determination that claims 1-6, 9, 12, 14, and 15 of U.S. Patent No 9,364,435 B2 were shown to be unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 102 in view of the grounds of unpatentability on which trial was instituted (Paper 15). The issues on appeal/cross-appeal additionally include the unconstitutionality of the panel entering the final written decision under the Appointments Clause of the Constitution. *See Arthrex, Inc. v. Smith & Nephew, Inc.*, No. 2018-2140 (Fed. Cir. Oct. 31, 2019); *see also UNILOC* 2017 LLC v. Facebook, Inc., No. 2018-2251 (Fed. Cir. Oct. 31, 2019) (non-precedential order).

Simultaneous with this filing and in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(1), this Notice is being filed with the Director and served on Petitioner in



accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 42.6(e). This Notice, along with the required fees, is also being filed with the Clerk's Office for the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit in accordance with Fed. Cir. R. 15(a)(1).
