**PATENT OWNER UNIVERSAL SECURE REGISTRY'S NOTICE OF
APPEAL TO THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR
THE FEDERAL CIRCUIT**

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2 and 90.3, and 35 U.S.C. §§ 141 and 142, Universal Secure Registry LLC (“Patent Owner”) respectfully gives Notice that it hereby appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit the October 8, 2019 Final Written Decision of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board (“Board”) in IPR2018-00809 (Paper 51) that claims 1, 2, 5–7, 9, and 12 of U.S. Patent No. 9,530,137 B2 (“the ’137 patent”) are unpatentable, denial of Patent Owner’s Contingent Motion to Amend, and all other prior interlocutory and underlying orders, decisions, rulings, findings and opinions that are adverse to Patent Owner related thereto or subsumed therein. Patent Owner electronically received the Final Written Decision on the day the decision was entered.

For the limited purpose of providing the Director with the information specified in 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), issues on Patent Owner’s appeal may include the Board’s determination that claims 1, 2, 5–7, 9, and 12 of the ’137 patent have been shown to be unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 103 in view of the grounds of unpatentability identified in the Board’s Final Written Decision, the Board’s denial of Patent Owner’s Contingent Motion to Amend, challenges to any findings supporting these determinations, the Board’s failure to properly consider evidence of record, the Board’s legal errors in undertaking the above analyses, the Board’s findings that conflict with the evidence of record and are not supported by

substantial evidence, the Board's findings with respect to objective indicia of nonobviousness, and all other prior interlocutory and underlying orders, decisions, rulings, findings and opinions decided adversely to Patent Owner.

Simultaneous with this filing and in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a), this Notice of Appeal is filed with the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, filed with the Board, and served upon Petitioner in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 42.6(e).

In addition, this Notice of Appeal, along with the required fees, is being filed with the Clerk's Office for the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit in accordance with Fed. Cir. R. 15(a)(1).

In addition to this Notice of Appeal, a copy of the Final Written Decision (Paper No. 51) is being submitted to the Federal Circuit Court of Appeals CM/ECF System and to the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office. That same Final Written Decision is not being refiled with the Board, which already has a copy.
