5. Obviousness of claim 3 under 35 U.S.C. § 103 in view of Mizutani;
6. Any issues specified by Patent Owner in its request for Oral Argument;
7. Any other issues raised in papers yet to be filed, such as Motions to Exclude;
8. Any other issues the Board deems necessary for issuing a final written decision.
